SECTION 1 – WEBSITE TERMS & CONDITIONS

1.1 Scope

These Terms & Conditions govern all services provided by ALPHA SAILING RS LIMITED ("Company"), including:

- Sailing training (adults and minors)
- Professional training programs
- Local and international regattas
- Corporate sailing events
- Bareboat and independent charter
- Fleet management services
- Any maritime activity organized by the Company



By registering, booking, making payment, or participating in any activity, you agree to these Terms.

1.2 Electronic Acceptance

By submitting an online form, completing payment, or clicking "I Agree," you confirm that:

- You have read and understood these Terms;
 - You accept them as legally binding;
 - You agree to the Liability Waiver contained herein.

1.3 Payments

- Payments may include deposits and full program fees.
 - Deposits may be non-refundable unless stated otherwise.
 - Online payments are processed via secure third-party providers.
 - The Company does not store full card details.

1.4 Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.
 - Refund eligibility depends on notice period and program type.
 - No refund is provided after program commencement unless agreed in writing.
 - The Company may reschedule activities due to safety or weather.

1.5 Weather & Force Majeure

The Company may cancel, postpone, or modify activities due to:

- Weather conditions
- Safety concerns
- Technical issues
- Government restrictions
- Events beyond reasonable control (force majeure)

In force majeure cases, rescheduling may be offered. Refunds are not guaranteed.

1.6 Corporate Bookings

For corporate or group events:

- The booking entity is responsible for participant conduct;
 - Damage may be invoiced to the booking entity;
 - The Company is not liable for internal disputes.

1.7 Charter & Independent Sailing

For bareboat or unsupervised sailing:

- A damage checklist is completed before departure;
 - The charterer assumes full responsibility during use;
 - Financial liability applies for damage, grounding, sail damage, towing, or recovery;
 - Liability is limited to actual repair or replacement cost unless gross negligence is legally proven.

Separate Charter or Damage Deposit Agreements may apply.

1.8 Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by Cyprus law:

- The Company is not liable for indirect or consequential losses;
 - The Company is not liable for travel or accommodation expenses;
 - Total liability shall not exceed the amount paid for the specific activity;
 - Nothing excludes liability for proven gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

1.9 Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of the Republic of Cyprus. Any dispute shall be subject exclusively to Cyprus courts.

SECTION 2 – PARTICIPATION & LIABILITY WAIVER

2.1 Assumption of Risk

Sailing and competitive regattas are high-risk maritime activities.

Risks include but are not limited to:



- Severe or rapidly changing weather
- Capsize or collision
- Equipment failure
- Drowning
- Rope injuries and falls
- Physical exhaustion
- Limited emergency access at sea

Participation is voluntary and entirely at your own risk.

2.2 Fitness to Participate

By participating, you confirm that:

- You are physically and mentally fit;
 - You can swim adequately;
 - You disclosed relevant medical conditions;
 - You are not under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

2.3 Release of Liability

You release and discharge the Company, its directors, instructors, employees, contractors, race officials, and partners from claims relating to:

- Injury
 - Disability
 - Death
 - Property damage
 - Financial loss
-



This applies even in cases of negligence, except where gross negligence or wilful misconduct is proven.

2.4 Indemnification

You agree to indemnify the Company for claims arising from:

- Your conduct;
 - Violation of maritime regulations;
 - Damage to third parties;
 - Misuse of equipment.

2.5 Regattas

For competitive events:

- Participation is voluntary;
 - Decisions to start or continue racing are your responsibility;
 - Race Committee decisions are final;
 - The Company is not responsible for tactical race decisions.

2.6 Minors

For participants under 18:

- A parent or legal guardian must accept these Terms;
 - The parent/guardian accepts responsibility on behalf of the minor;
 - Claims are waived to the fullest extent permitted by law.

2.7 Media Consent

Unless written objection is provided before participation, you grant permission for photographs and videos to be used for promotional purposes.
